don't reach it again, and that means other things will not be reached also. And I'm prepared to deliver, and I shall. What's going to make it so easy for me, usually...well, not usually, every other year it's 90 days. This is only 60 days. So a third of the fight has been waged already without, pardon the expression, a shot being fired. I had said earlier some things about the conditions in my community. I do a weekly program on cable, and it gives me the opportunity to talk about things that confront the black community, and anybody who wants to eavesdrop can do so. I've been speaking against the ease with which guns can be obtained by young black men, and this is a transcript of what I said during one of the programs several months ago: Let me tell you all something else. If there were as many shootings in the white community as there are in ours, if white youngsters as young as 15 years old had pistols, federal agencies, such as Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, would not let that happen without finding the source of those guns and cutting it off. Do you think U.S. Attorney Mike Heavican, who hypocritically gets on television and talks about all of the crime they're fighting, would not personally marshal federal forces to stop those guns from coming into a white community? Do you think Chief Warren...Chief Warren would not tell his white cops, you've got your snitch core out there, you know or can find out where these guns are coming from and I want them stopped, if it involved the white community? If it affected the white community, we know that's what would happen, but the guns are doing the damage in our community. I tell you that these white people and officials hate us, but you don't believe it, do you? We have some crazy people among us. We have Uncle Toms, Aunt Jemimas and crooks. We have some fools, but we are not authorized under the law to enforce the law in our community. I'm going to contact the new special agent in charge of the Omaha FBI, which I did. He just got here in January. I'm going to give him a call, probably tomorrow, and mention to him the things I'm saying here tonight and tell him that I want to know why federal agents are not stopping these guns from coming in here. This thing is similar to the sale of dope, where the dope dealer cannot work in secret. He has got to be known, because volume is what he needs. He wants to sell a lot of dope to a lot of people. That's why everybody knows who the dope dealer is. Authorities don't stop dope dealers in our community for the same reason
