SENATOR COMBS: Right. That's correct.

SENATOR FLOOD: Okay. So when you discuss a place of worship, you're thinking of anything from a church to a synagogue, a mosque, without regard to exactly whether it's the primary place of worship or possibly a classroom, a social hall, a fellowship room, an atrium, a library, a bride's room, a reading room, a music room. All of that is included within your concept of "place of worship."

SENATOR COMBS: That's correct, because many places of worship have all those things.

SENATOR FLOOD: Okay. I wanted to ask you those questions and clarify your intent. I have no further questions. Thank you.

SENATOR COMBS: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Flood. Further lights that are on, Senator Erdman, followed by Senators Thompson, Schimek, Kruse, Chambers, and Howard. Senator Erdman.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President. I guess I didn't rise as quickly as Senator Flood, but we'll see how this goes. Senator Chambers, would you yield to a question? I need to understand one of your concerns with the way the bill is drafted.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, I mean I'll answer.

SENATOR ERDMAN: On page 9 of the amendment, AMO810 is the committee amendment, and it may not...I may not have heard your analysis correctly and so I need to seek clarification before I understand. You mention that the process, as outlined for a peace officer or an emergency services personnel, they may secure the handgun.
