Our first vote will be the vote on Senator Chambers' motion to reconsider. All those in favor signify by saying (sic) aye; those opposed, nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 4 ayes, 33 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to reconsider.

SPEAKER BRASHEAR: The motion to reconsider is not adopted. The question before the body is now the adoption of AMO810, the Judiciary Committee amendments to LB 454. All those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER BRASHEAR: The committee amendments are adopted. The next question before the body is the advancement to E & R Initial of LB 454. All those in favor signify by voting aye; those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Mr. Clerk, please record. A record vote has been requested.
