SENATOR CUDABACK: Only yours, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then I'm going to have to speak and figure something out here. Senator Mines, would you turn to page 21? And, the Chair, are we on the committee amendment right now?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. So I would have other opportunities.

SENATOR MINES: Sure.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Mines, when we get to page 21 of the bill, the green copy, the discussion goes to those entities which are not covered. They slip the net, in other words, I believe.

SENATOR MINES: That's a unique term, Senator, but you're correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Why do we put, on page 21, contracts...starting in line 8, "Contracts entered into pursuant to the Burial Pre-Need Sale Act"? Is it felt that there wouldn't be any undue pressure or whatever brought to bear for people who are looking at a pre-need burial contract, or just why is that exempted?

SENATOR MINES: Well, I understand it's a different kind of business.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So why is it even in this bill?

SENATOR MINES: I can't answer that, Senator. Oh, it does not apply to.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right. But I don't believe...or let me not state what I don't believe. Does this listing include every entity and activity to which this bill does not apply?

SENATOR MINES: Yes, it does.
