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on page 13 of the bill and it's defined at page 21. Why is the term "insurance producer" used instead of "agent"? I'm curious.

SENATOR MINES: It's a new terminology. It means the same thing, a producer, a managing agent.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: When you say new terminology, you mean in the trade?

SENATOR MINES: In the trade. I'm sorry.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Good, so that I can get away from that. On page 14, I will tell you what it is I want to ask you about.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, that's not what I want to ask him about. (Laugh)

SENATOR MINES: We've been there once.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Let me see. Well, I will locate it, but it has to do with a word that might be more appropriate than what is in the bill. I will wait until after the committee amendments are adopted, and then, when we continue the discussion, I will have found it.

SENATOR MINES: Thank you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Further discussion on the committee amendments? Senator Mines, there are no lights on. I recognize you to close on adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR MINES: Thank you, Mr. President. And just to review quickly for the body the amendment, AM1901: it inserts an amended section in 44-1988 of Title Insurers Act; and alters the domestic title insurer calculation, that they must maintain a
