SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Landis?

SENATOR LANDIS: I'm standing here thinking to myself that I should probably ask the Chair to drag everybody in here, but I've thought better of it. (Laughter)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Record please, Mister....

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments are adopted.
