CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. The house is under call. Senator Heidemann voting yes. Senator Dwite Pedersen voting yes. Senator Flood voting yes. Senator Hudkins voting yes. Senator Schimek voting yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Baker's amendment to the Baker amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: FA381 has been adopted. Back now to discussion of AM1859. Senator Baker, there are no lights on. You're recognized to close on AM1859 to LB 248.
