the closing on FA392. The question before the body is, shall FA392 be adopted to LB 778? All in favor vote aye; opposed vote nay. The question before the body is the Chambers amendment, FA392, to LB 778. Have you all voted on the question who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of FA392, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: FA392 has been adopted. Next motion, when you get time, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Chambers would offer FA393. (Legislative Journal page 556.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, to open on FA393 to LB 778.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I will read the locations where this amendment will occur, then I will state what the amendment is and what it does. Page 47, line 16; page 54, line 24; page 62, line 1, I would strike the two words "as having" and insert in their place "to have." This is the structure of the language now: "the board shall deem the applicant as having met the requirements." It should say, in my opinion, "the board shall deem the applicant to have met the requirements." I don't know whether Senator...I see her looking at her gadget; I don't know if she's paying attention to this. She knew who I was talking about. She looked up. I will ask a senator, who shall remain nameless, if she will respond to a question, and if she's willing, she will take the floor.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It's wide open, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'll ask Senator Hudkins if she would respond to a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Hudkins, would you respond?

SENATOR HUDKINS: Yes.
