SENATOR LANGEMEIER: I have.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I would substitute the word "applicable" for "respective." What is your reaction to that?

SENATOR LANGEMEIER: I would accept that amendment, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, I'm through.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Any discussion on the Chambers motion? I see no lights on, and Senator Chambers does not wish to close. The question before the body is adoption of FA394 to LB 778. All in favor vote aye; opposed vote nay. We're voting on the adoption of the Chambers amendment, FA394, which amends LB 778. Have you all voted who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: FA394 has been adopted. (Doctor of the day introduced.) On to the next motion. Mr. Clerk, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Chambers would offer FA395.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, to open on FA395 to LB 778.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. And, Mr. President, this is an offered amendment which I want to discuss with Senator Langemeier, because perhaps it is not one that needs to be adopted, or even should be adopted. But when we put an amendment on the Clerk's desk, we could, but we don't, write a question mark after it to indicate that maybe it is not something that should go forward. But, Senator Langemeier, I do have a question as to whether this next amendment would be necessary.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Langemeier, would you respond?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm going to read it now.
