Senator Landis, you're recognized to close on Revenue Committee amendment.

SENATOR LANDIS: I would ask for the adoption of the committee amendment that makes appropriate the amnesty period, so that it is consistent with the existence of a certified service provider, and that's the better standard. I ask for its adoption.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question is for the committee amendments to be adopted to LB 887. All in favor vote aye; opposed vote nay. We're voting on the adoption of the committee amendment, AM1914, to LB 887. Have you all voted on the adoption of the committee amendments who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Committee amendments have been adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Nothing further at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There are no lights on. Senator Landis, you're recognized to close on advancement of LB 887.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, and I appreciate the chance to discuss this. The streamlined process will be with us.
