name to you for appointment to the Environmental Quality Michael is a new appointee to the council, representing heavy industry. He appeared before the committee for his confirmation hearing on February 2, 2006. His hometown is Crawford, Nebraska. He attended the University of Utah in Salt Lake City. He is the health, safety and environmental manager for the Crow Butte Resources. Michael has over 30 years of experience in the nuclear and environmental industry, including the responsibility for all management of environmental health and safety compliance programs in an operating uranium mine, and for project benefit of environmental reclamation, health, physics, and waste treatment projects. He is a member of the Nebraska Safety Center Mine Safety Advisory Council, the National Mining Association Uranium Environmental Subcommittee, and a member of the Crawford Board of Education. The committee vote was unanimous and I would tell you that I don't remember the exact year but here three or four years ago the Natural Resources Committee did visit that mine. He was one of the persons that talked to us, and it's a very interesting operation. But as you think of a mine, this isn't a traditional mine where you go underground, but they do pump water and they do extract uranium, and it's a very interesting operation and seems to be a very environmentally friendly operation in northwest Nebraska, in the Crawford area.
