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the emergency clause.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. There are several lights on. If you don't wish to address the committee amendments, I will leave your lights on. Senator Janssen. I do not see Senator Janssen. Senator Stuhr.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. I just want to stand in support of the committee amendment which added the emergency clause, and I can say that the person involved in this racetrack owner would be very, very thankful if we did add the emergency clause. But I think this is a good idea. It does make use of some of our spare tires and it's also a safety factor, and I believe racing has certainly become an economic development event and program in many communities, so I stand in support of the amendment and the bill. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Stuhr. Senator Burling, did you wish to address committee amendments?

SENATOR BURLING: Thank you, Mr. President. I just wanted to encourage your support for the amendment and thank Chairman Schrock and legal counsel and the Natural Resources Committee for their help on this, and it was very much appreciated, and I urge your approval of this amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Burling. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature, with respect to this amendment, I understand that there is a timing problem, Senator Burling, and you're trying to get some immediate help to a particular individual who would like to go this route in the near future and I, for one, would certainly like to accommodate you and make that work. Would you be amenable on Select File to, after we adopt this amendment, assuming the amendment is attached, tailoring it down so that people who come after your particular individual, let's say after a particular point in time that we could identify in the bill, would have to not only submit a disposal plan but it would have to be approved by the
