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department?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Burling, would you...?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Because...

SENATOR BURLING: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...the way this is structured right now, if I'm reading it right, there's no approval by the department required, by the Department of Environmental Control, with respect to the disposition plan, and so there's really, except what might be being done informally, there's really no legal hammer that would compel the individual you're thinking about to put in a plan that had any particular meaning or teeth. Isn't that accurate on a...in a...if you look at it just from the point of view of legal requirements?

SENATOR BURLING: Yes, Senator Beutler. I think you might be addressing the next amendment. This is the E clause amendment we're talking about right now. I'll have an amendment following this...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR BURLING: ...that addresses what you're talking about, and you're absolutely right. I appreciate support for this urgency this year and then, after that, subsequent users like this, yes, they'll be addressed either on Select File or next year.

SENATOR BEUTLER: You would have no objection...

SENATOR BURLING: No problem. No problem.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...to further amendment on that.

SENATOR BURLING: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Thank you very...
