SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Burling. You've heard the opening on AM2174 to LB 818. Open for discussion. Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, and, Senator Burling, don't panic, don't get heartburn, I wish my life were as uncomplicated as some of my colleagues' so that I could prioritize a bill such as this. I read in the paper something that puzzled me. It was something I had never seen or read about having been done by a judge. Now, the judge who did it is a Lancaster County District Judge. His name is Steven Burns. This pen that I'm holding up has more intelligence in the cap than I'm taking off the pen than Judge Steven Burns has in his entire body. The man is a dunce. The only reason he got appointed to be judge by former Governor Nelson was because he was Nelson's finance man.
