SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mines, did you wish to...

SENATOR MINES: Mr. President, thank you. Let me just reiterate, this is a compromise, all sides have agreed, and I would appreciate your vote in support of the amendment, as well as the underlying bill, LB 875. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Mines. You've heard the opening on AM2201. Open for discussion. Seeing no lights on, Senator Beutler or Mines, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, Senator Cudaback, I suppose, in a way, it's not a bang but a whimper of sorts to pass this amendment, if you look at it in terms of the need for an overall solution to the National Warranty problem. But on the other hand, it is somewhat more than a whimper, and beyond that, it's probably about all we can do, absent upsetting the applecart completely for our automobile dealers and the whole system. So I hope you'll think it important to make this small but important repair. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. You've heard the closing on AM2201 to LB 875. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Voting on adoption of the Beutler-Mines amendment, AM2201 to LB 875. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Beutler and Mines' amendment.
