SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. You're correct. You know what my motion is for, correct?

SENATOR COMBS: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It's to kill this bill.

SENATOR COMBS: That is correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: What is your pleasure this morning, as far as what I would do on this bill?

SENATOR COMBS: We may continue discussion of your motion.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Combs, wait a minute. I better rephrase the question. If I will do what you would like me to do, what would you have me do with my motion?

SENATOR COMBS: Well, actually, I would like you to withdraw it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Done. Mr. President, I want to withdraw that motion.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Combs would move to amend with AM2169. (Legislative Journal page 581.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Combs, you're recognized to open on AM2169 to LB 454A.

SENATOR COMBS: As explained earlier, I explained and went through what this amendment will do. It will become LB 454A. And the changing of the cash funds over to the State Patrol, it accomplishes that. Fiscal Office did a lot of work on that for
