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SENATOR FOLEY: ...have just a little bit of a dialogue.

SENATOR CUDABACK: ...yield to a question from Senator Foley?

SENATOR LOUDEN: Yes.

SENATOR FOLEY: Senator Louden, again, thank you for your work on this bill. As you know, I've got...also got a bill that seeks to provide a revenue stream for the ongoing maintenance of the veterans cemetery program. And I presume that my legislation might also be helpful and needed if this cemetery is constructed?

SENATOR LOUDEN: Yes, that's the one that you have some license fees or...

SENATOR FOLEY: Yes. Yes, that's correct, Senator.

SENATOR LOUDEN: ...license plate fees, or something like that, be go into the Maintenance Fund?

SENATOR FOLEY: Right.

SENATOR LOUDEN: Well, yeah,...

SENATOR FOLEY: Did I understand you to say that some of the monies that you've...that have been raised thus far could be used toward maintenance, in addition to construction?

SENATOR LOUDEN: The way the federal government does this, we raise the design costs, and after that has been raised and they start the construction and that sort of thing, they will return the money that we have put in for the design cost.

SENATOR FOLEY: I see. So (inaudible)...

SENATOR LOUDEN: And the way we've set this up, that design cost money will then go into this, I think Senator Hartnett set up an endowment fund for maintenance of these state veterans cemeteries.
