to LB 173. Have you all voted on the question who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Chambers amendment has been adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend, FA428. (Legislative Journal page 606.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, to open on FA428 to the committee amendments to LB 173.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature, this is an amendment which I think will give some clarification. When you look on page 2, at the bottom of the page, it is telling you conditions under which certain things will happen, and that ends with a period, in line 1 on page 3. However, there is an exception to this language that you see printed. If you look down on line 23 on page 3, it says, "Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section," which is the one that I was just referring to. So what I'm going to do is offer this amendment which, at the end of subsection (a), would add the language, "except as provided in subsection (e) of this section," and it gives notice that the language contained in this subsection (a) is not the full story on what is being dealt with. So my language will make it clear that subsection (a), as it is written, is not a stand-alone subsection. It is modified elsewhere in the bill. My language points out where in the bill that modification will take place. If you have any questions, I will answer them, but I don't know how to explain it more clearly than I've done. Thank you, Mr. President.
