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thereon and deducting any lawful charges, that is held or owing in this state in the ordinary course of holder's business," and so forth. Do they mean there is this income or increment thereon, and after deducting any lawful charges, then you wind up with what it is that you're going to be addressing?

SENATOR HUDKINS: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So if I would insert the word "after" in front of "deducting," so it says, "after deducting," would that make it clearer what is being said here?

SENATOR HUDKINS: Yes, I think so.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. And if it turns out...if the bill moves, if it turns out that inserting this word does not do what I think it ought to do, I wouldn't object to its being removed. But if the word is put in, then it clarifies for me what I think they're trying to say. So here's what the amendment would do: On page 4, in lines 19 and 25, after the word "and," I would insert the word "after." And to say it another way, the word "after" would precede the word "deducting." If you have any questions, I will answer them. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the opening on FA432. Open for discussion on that motion. Senator Chambers, there are no lights on. Senator Chambers waives closing.
