SENATOR CHAMBERS: So give me a dollar amount, and it doesn't have to be exactly half, and I will accept what you offer on...you say on this one.

SENATOR BYARS: I would say, given that you're at \$30,000...did you go to \$30,000 even on '06-07?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR BYARS: Then I would say \$65,000 on fiscal year 2007-2008.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Two times \$65,000...

SENATOR BYARS: No, \$65,000.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, I'm saying, 2 times that, 2 times 5 is 10; 2 times 6 is 12, plus 1 is 13. That's \$130,000. But the amount we're dealing with is \$105,000. So you don't really want to cut it in half. You want to give them more than half.

SENATOR BYARS: Well, there's a little more than half...there's a little more than...yeah.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: See, if we said \$55,000, that would give them more than half, because double \$55,000 would be \$110,000.

SENATOR BYARS: Okay, let's say...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And what they have here is \$105,000.

SENATOR BYARS: Let's say \$55,000.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. So can you talk for a few minutes while I draft this amendment correctly, and then I'll be through with your bill.

SENATOR BYARS: It's been suggested to me, Senator, that in light of the topic that we're discussing, that I definitely should not be the last one to let you down, Senator.
