February 10, 2006 LB 85A

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend with the amendment as we're processing it right now. (FA438, Legislative Journal page 616.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on the amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And here is what the amendment says. In the Byars amendment, which is AM1879, in line 3 strike "\$59,594" and insert in its place "\$30,000." In line 5, strike "\$105,226" and insert in its place "\$55,000." I was informed by our very capable Fiscal Office staff that I need not worry about putting a figure in for the federal amount because that is an estimate anyway, but it would follow and be determined by the amount we're going to contribute from the General Fund. So that will be taken care of. And as amended, dealing only with the General Fund amounts, that is all we need to carry out what Senator Byars and I had discussed, and what Senator Pederson had gotten involved in also. If you have any questions, I'm prepared to answer them.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the opening on the Chambers amendment. Open for discussion. Senator Chambers, there are no lights on. Senator Chambers waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of FA438 to LB 85A. All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. We're voting on adoption of the Chambers amendment. Have you all voted on the...FA438 who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment has been agreed to.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Flood, for a motion, please.

SENATOR FLOOD: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 85A
