SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...will now no longer be licensed to do the things that that CDL authorization allows. That's what you're telling us?

SENATOR BAKER: Senator Chambers, there is an appeal process. It would take a considerable amount of time and there are windows of opportunity to get back in compliance with the federal regulations. I don't know what that time frame is, but it will be considerable.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. And I'm not going to try to strike this, but I would appreciate it if you would tell us if every one of these categories of persons contained in Senator Langemeier's amendment is required by the federal regulation.

SENATOR BAKER: And we will do that, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. That's all I will have on Senator Langemeier's amendment. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Langemeier, there are no further lights on. You're recognized to close on your amendment. Senator Langemeier waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of the Langemeier amendment, FA439. All in favor vote aye; opposed vote nay. Question before the body is the Langemeier amendment, FA439, which is an amendment to LB 853. Have you all voted on the question who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 mays on the adoption of Senator Langemeier's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Langemeier amendment has been adopted. Mr. Clerk, next motion, please.
