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got it. So when Hergert's lawyer brought this document, he left a lot of open space at the bottom so "Kangaroo" could make his paw print on it, which stood for his signature. I should apologize to all the kangaroos, but you need some terminology, if only by way of example, to give an idea of what it is you're trying to describe. This issue is far from being concluded. I think Ben Nelson ought to be ashamed of himself and embarrassed. I think every judge who is a part of the Lancaster County District Court ought to be embarrassed and ashamed, and they should have taken some action. But since they all went along with it and were silent, all that's needed that a rogue judge not be held to account or called to account...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...is that nonrogue judges do nothing. So what are the other Lancaster County district judges doing? Nothing. Nothing. They're going to be trotting over here asking for a salary increase, maybe not this year. Ordinarily, I would say no to that, but if there is any argument for the need to provide a decent salary for judges, "Kangaroo" Burns is that argument. When that is the only type of person you can draw to the bench, something is needed to reach out and cause others who are more capable to express an interest in being appointed to that position. So "Kangaroo" has been temporarily put in a pen, and we're going to see what other corrective action may be forthcoming. Thank you, Mr. President, and I withdraw that pending amendment that I have up there.

SENATOR CUDABACK: FA441 is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, anything further on the bill?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further on the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Back to discussion of the bill itself. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, because this bill is such a serious matter and deals with technical issues, I'm not offering any amendments at this point, because we intend to do additional
