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program for.

SENATOR BEUTLER: All right. So it's your intent that wherever EPA allows it, this language would require the setting up of a program in that...for that particular emission?

SENATOR SCHROCK: That is correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And there is no...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...is there any value in giving our local department the prerogative to choose which programs they might want to set up a trading program for, rather than requiring them to set up a program for every one the EPA allows?

SENATOR SCHROCK: I don't have a good answer for that, Senator Beutler, but we'll do some checking.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Let me flip over, then, to page 22, Senator, and I want to talk about some existing language, just for a second. On page 22, starting on line 15, there's the authorization to charge an emission fee; are you following?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, I am.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And as I read that language, and tell me if you read it the same way, but regardless of the Consumer Price Index, if they need to charge more in order to pay all reasonable direct and indirect costs of developing and administering the air quality permit system, they...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...can do that; is that accurate?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, it is, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah. I see where...
