SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Preister. Mr. Clerk, motion on the desk.

CLERK: Senator Chambers would move to amend Senator Burling's amendment with FA444. (Legislative Journal page 657.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on FA444.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, not only should I stop reading these bills; I should stop reading these amendments. But I'm kind...it's become kind of an obsession with me now. There's a compulsion that I feel. I'd like to ask Senator Burling a question or two.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Burling, would you respond?

SENATOR BURLING: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Burling. And I want Senator Cornett to know that I haven't forgotten her. I have her on the radar screen, and she is...I can't say, in my prayers; she is in my thoughts. Senator Burling, who drafted this language for your amendment?

SENATOR BURLING: The Bill Room.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: The Bill Room? The Bill Room? Think about it.

SENATOR BURLING: The people. The staff.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Where? Which staff? The staff who works where?

SENATOR BURLING: A combination of my staff and Bill Room staff.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And the Bill Room staff.
