SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's all I have, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Further discussion on AM2207? There are no lights on, Senator Stuhr. You're recognized to close. Senator Stuhr waives closing. The question before the body is, should the committee amendments, AM2207, be adopted to LB 1019? All in favor vote aye; opposed vote nay. We're voting on adoption of the Nebraska Retirement Committee amendments. Have you all voted on the question who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments have been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Back to discussion of the advancement of LB 1019. Open for discussion. Senator Stuhr, there are no lights on. Chair recognizes you to close on advancement of LB 1019.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. Again, LB 1019 would make technical changes to the operation of both the Nebraska Employees Retirement Board, the Nebraska Investment Council, various retirement systems administered by PERB, and also the Class V retirement system. And I would certainly, at this time, like to thank all of my committee members who have been meeting over the lunch hour and sacrificing that time for work on these proposals that are before us, and also for all of those that came to testify on these matters. And I ask for the body's support in LB...in passing LB 1019. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Stuhr. You've heard the closing on advancement. The question before the body is, shall LB 1019 advance to E & R Initial, as amended? All in favor vote aye; opposed vote nay. Voting on advancement of LB 1019. Have you all voted on the advancement who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
