SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators please report to the Chamber. The house is under call. The house is under call. Senator Combs, Senator Don Pederson, Senator Hudkins, Senator Kremer, Senator Louden. I'm sorry; Senator Louden, you're here. Senator Synowiecki, you're also here. Senator...Senator Chambers, and Senator Kremer. The house is under call. All members are present or accounted for. The question before the body is the Beutler amendment, AM2270 to the committee amendments to LB 188. All in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Voting on adoption of the Chambers (sic) amendment. I'm sorry, the Beutler amendment. (Laughter) Senator Chambers walked in last. Have you all voted on the Beutler amendment who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Beutler amendment has been adopted, and I do raise the call. Back to discussion of the committee amendments to LB 188. Open for discussion. Senator Schimek, there are no lights on. You're recognized to close on the committee amendments, as Chairperson of the committee.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I will be brief. The Beutler amendment actually incorporated the committee amendment into his amendment, or into that amendment, and so the...actually, the Beutler amendment became the committee amendment, and so I would simply urge its adoption.
