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SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then did it suddenly become red?

SENATOR FRIEND: You're absolutely right. You don't even want to know why, though, right?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Huh?

SENATOR FRIEND: You don't want to know why. Are you asking me why that happened?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, no. I'm not asking why. You can do that on your own time. You have...(singing) you may speak your mind, but not on my (laugh) time.

SENATOR FRIEND: Yeah, that's good.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator Friend.

SENATOR FRIEND: Thank you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Members of the Legislature, even though the discussion is going in the direction it is, there's a serious point underlying what I'm doing, and everybody on this floor knows what it is. Everybody knows what it is. Seldom do we have an issue where everybody is aware of what is entailed, but what I'm offering here shows how ridiculous my colleagues have been when they want to call a zygote, an embryo,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...a fetus, an unborn child. Was that my third time, Mr. President?

SENATOR CUDABACK: That was your opening, Senator Chambers. Now we've heard the opening on FA452 to FA449. For continuation with discussion, Senator Chambers, followed by Senators Combs and Friend. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I will let others speak first.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Combs.
