February 16, 2006 LB 856

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Thank you, Senator, very much. I'd yield the remainder of my time back.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Further discussion on advancement of LB 856? Seeing no lights on, Senator Kremer, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR KREMER: Okay. Do we need a call of the house? Maybe there's enough here.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Are you asking for a call of the house?

SENATOR KREMER: Yes, why don't we, just to make sure that there's plenty here. While I'm closing they can come.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Been a request for a call of the house. All in favor vote aye; all opposed vote nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unexcused members please report to the Chamber. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Kremer, if you wish to continue, your clock is running.

SENATOR KREMER: Yes, I will. I think...there may be even enough people here right now, but...and I won't go into any lengthy discussion on the bill itself, because the committee amendments become the bill, and I did close on that, and talked about the two bills, that were more surveillance and ability to monitor the poultry industry and to be able to respond to any bird flu or diseases that might come, in a timely manner to stop it before it gets too far. The next bill, dealing with the exotic animal auctions and the trade meet, or the swap meets. The last one, the mandatory price reporting, I think I mentioned all those, and you all understand that. So with that, I ask your support for LB 856, as amended.
