SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, Senator Cornett and I did have a very good discussion after we adjourned the other day, and I was aware of this quote, and I think it is what we would call dynamite. But I'm not going to comment here (laugh). I like the quote, and it has various applications. But I've begun to think about my colleague--very, very tricky. And I'm quoting...the lady who works with me is Cindy Grandberry, as you all may know. She has her little grandniece who has been coming down, and she's five years old. And kids, as Art Linkletter said, say the darndest things. There are two doors that I have to my office, so she was on one side of the office, and I came through this other door. And then she saw me. She said, how did you get in here? So I went and I showed her. She said, you can come through that door? I said, yes. She said, very tricky. So we call it the tricky door. Well, I think what Senator Cornett is doing is very tricky. She's going to take a tiger, declaw him, defang him, and turn him into a little tabby cat, and I can't let that happen. So I appreciate the quote and the discussion or comments that I was going to engage in. won't now, because I cannot show any weakness. It might be misconstrued as support for the bill, and I cannot let that happen. Since I'm on Senator Cornett's time, I'm giving it back to her, because she may have some additional things she'd like to say, and she might provoke me into saying something about it, but I doubt it.
