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You see, we're supposed to be so dumb that we can't put two things together. But I'm going to show how they tricked the Legislature, and how the Legislature, gullible dumbbells that they are, collectively, will go for the okey-doke and swallow hook, line, and sinker whatever is put out there by somebody who is speaking on behalf of business or the wealthy or the elitists. You couldn't get a bill out of committee if it was going to improve the health coverage for poor children, give additional assistance to poor single mothers. No! You can't do that. You'll find ways to cut, cut, cut, and that's what Bush and his minions in Washington are doing, and they have little imitators and would-be Bushes here. As some people said, they're shrubs here; they're weeds here. They're not like the mighty tiger she read about. They're like the little sharp-teethed jackal who'll follow behind the tiger to eat the leavings of the tiger. So they attack the weak, the vulnerable, and that's what this and other legislatures will do. But it's going to be difficult to do that, to hurt those groups,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and it's going to be difficult to favor these elitists. I handed out something, I think, the other day, because I don't see it among the items that I have for handing out here today--a packet of...oh, she's holding it up--items where I pointed out the fibs told about how that convention center was going to make money, and I spoke against it, and I said they'd be coming back. And now Senator Brashear is the one coming back to try to get the Legislature to give up the money that I warned would be sought. They are the ones who said, we will limit everything we're looking for from the state, to the convention center. And I said, it's not going to make money. But they felt if they could get the convention center, they would add the arena, lump them together, then get the state to foot the bill. And if they...
