the people they are trying to recruit. Nebraska's tax situation, in a number of ways, leads us to a challenging position recruiting people from other states, particularly this class of personnel that are retiring from the military, because they have so many options around the country where they can They are most highly recruited to Colorado, Texas, and Florida. Some of the challenges we face, besides the fact that we tax military retirement in the state, I have from the last job fair that they hosted at Offutt Air Force Base, one of the statements coming out of the job fair was, one of the obstacles to recruiting people to Nebraska has always been Nebraska's taxes. It is not just income taxes. The issue spreads to other areas such as property taxes, vehicle registration, just to name a couple. The same issues arise when we are trying to recruit potential employees to come to Nebraska. If we make the tax situation a little better in some area, particularly this area on their military retirement, we can attract qualified persons to these positions. And I think that I've demonstrated, through testimony, how much that we need to maintain these businesses in the area to support Offutt community. Thank you. I turn my time over to Senator Chambers.
