opening on AM2348. Mr. Clerk, motion on the desk, please.

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend Senator Baker's amendment. (FA479, Legislative Journal page 716.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, to open on your amendment to the Baker amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature. Senator Baker, let me just indicate to you what this amendment does. On your amendment, on lines 3 and 4 and 5 of page 1, it says that these particular sections "shall not apply to individuals who operate commercial motor vehicles for military purposes, including," and then it lists a number of different types of military personnel. But the general statement is applying to individuals who operate commercial vehicles, so I put the language "including and limited to" the different categories that are set forth in your amendment. In other words, I didn't want the language to apply to...and, by the way, I'd like to discuss the letter you got from the U.S. Department of Transportation. But with respect to this particular amendment, do you have any objection to limiting it to, the exemption, to the categories that are listed on page 1? I'd yield to Senator Baker.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you. No, I certainly do not object to your amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. That would then exclude people who are not military people being excluded.

SENATOR BAKER: That's the way I take it. I still don't have your amendment up on our machine, but all your amendment does is add those words "and limited to" after "including"?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes.

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, that would be fine.
