SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...to get in that game with him. I'm going to push for my amendment, and should it fail, I will exact a price and I will see if the Legislature is willing to pay it, and if Senator Schrock is willing to pay it, and if those large-scale interests that he represents and speaks for are willing to pay it, because they may not get this bill at all. You may feel that on Select File you're willing to put me in my place by giving him what he wants, but by the time you get to Final Reading, there will be a lot of action over there and you have to weigh what is important to you. I have already totaled up the cost and I know what is important to me. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You heard the opening on FA488. Open for discussion. Senator Raikes, followed by Senator Chambers and others. Senator Raikes.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Speaking on Senator Chambers' amendment, but I think more generally on the issue, and what I'll try to do is share with you some perspective here, I went through this process recently. It would not...I'm through it, so it would not affect me, but in effect I was in a situation where, I guess as Senator Chambers mentioned, I was out of compliance with the regulations. Now, I had applied or I had complied with all the inspection requirements and all that sort of thing, but when the federal law, Clean Water Act, changed, the regulations that the DEQ in Nebraska enforced changed also. So given the new regulations and the new environment, I was not in compliance, so I proceeded to get myself in compliance. In my particular case, there was a cost-share program on the engineering expense which I participated in. That's kind of what got it started. But roughly what happened was, in order for me to get in compliance, the first thing I had to do was to do an engineering study for
