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SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR KREMER: And so I think we need to do this. I'm okay with the 10 percent coming out, because that was going to allow a large operation to grow. Five hundred head is talking about our small operations and we need to do it. I support Schrock's amendment and the overriding bill. Thank you very much.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Kremer. Further discussion? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I heard what Senator Raikes said. I listened to Senator Schrock, both when he was speaking on the mike and when he came here and we spoke briefly. And I listened to Senator Wehrbein and Senator Kremer. I don't know offhand how many years I've been on that Ag Committee and I've had more farmers come to me and thank me for being on that committee than they have any other person who ever served on that committee. They have watched me fight off the big interests in ag who would crush out, in fact, the little producer, because the senators in the Legislature are afraid of them and they fold, and that's why I have to do so much work. I shouldn't even serve on a Agriculture Committee. In fact, I was the one who saved it from being erased because some ag senator said the train is on the track, in terms of folding the Ag Committee in with another committee, and there'd be no Ag Committee. And it was my view that since so much in this state's life depends on agriculture, keep that committee, by name, if you get rid of some others. But they said, the train is coming, I'm not going to stand on the track. And I keep articles. I can show you if you doubt my word. I'm not going to show you anything. I don't care whether you doubt it or not. Pay attention. Learn things. You should have been reading it as it was going on. You know what I stood on this floor and said? I'm not only going to stand on the track, I'm going to derail the train. And you know what happened? I derailed the train. I did it, and any senators who were here at the time know that's true. The others had cut and run, and now they want me, one city slicker, to get out of the way. I talked about Atropos. Maybe people weren't paying attention when I talked about Atropos before. But there are three mythological
