And I'm going to take a lot of time on that bill, and I'm going to read from the transcript of the debates when they were coming down here, tricking the Legislature into going for it. Now that they want to add money from the arena, Omaha was the one who said leave the arena out and deal just with the convention, and I'm going to show you all...the convention center, where Mayor Daub said, when you build this convention center it will make Omaha a world-class city. This bill is a nail and I'm going to drop the hammer on the head of that nail. I gave you an opportunity to strike a deal, and you know I'll stick by mine, and I don't have to get anybody's permission. But I do believe I can stop that bill and I believe I can stop this one. You can show me that I'm wrong, and it won't be the first time, but it will not put an end to me and my efforts. There are a lot of targets on the agenda as far as I'm concerned and none of them will be exempt. I voted against adopting your rules, but I assure you everything I do will be well within the confines of your rules. I play by your rules. I master your rules and I'll beat you at your own game. You know why? Because I'm not a coward, I'm not a liar, and I'm not afraid of anything or anybody. That's why you don't hear me running around here, despite the threats I get, saying let me carry pistols hidden in my clothes. White people, the scariest people on the face of the earth, running around here, I got to carry a gun. For what? Who even knows you exist? Who even cares about you?
