Mr. President and members. I'd like to ask Senator Chambers a question or two, if I might.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mine deals with the automatic allowance, or requirement that there be an increase in all these critters. That's what my amendment would strike.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: So it takes out all the critters?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, that's what mine would do.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Doesn't do anything about the 10 percent?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That would be included...mine...the 10 percent falls within what I would be striking.
