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SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...in livestock run into that, because sometimes you can make a contract for the delivery of fuel, heating oil, to your home, and you can either make that long-term contract now, or just pay as you need it and hope that you're going to come out ahead. So what you're saying there, I understand. But, Senator Schrock, has anybody thought about trying to get some kind of a system where a determination could be made if this county board or zoning commission would allow the expansion if the person made these modifications, and put those two things together?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Well, I'm not tracking real close here, but if a person wants to expand, you can get the permit, but of course, the county board has to approve;...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right.

SENATOR SCHROCK: ...or modify, county board has to approve.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right.

SENATOR SCHROCK: And so...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But if a person is required, must make the modifications,...

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...like we're talking about here, if you're going to put something in the law, and it may not take the law, make it possible for the person to find out if the county board is going to grant the authority or the permit to expand to offset the cost of the modification. Otherwise,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...the person goes out of business. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock and Senator
