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SENATOR CHAMBERS: And on the dairy cattle, dairy cows?

SENATOR SCHROCK: We could pick a different number, because 5,000 head of dairy cattle is pretty large.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, no, we're not going to give them...they're 350 right now, I think.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yeah, I understand,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR SCHROCK: ...but I mean a 5,000-head lot is pretty large.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, okay.

SENATOR SCHROCK: I could go to a cutoff point at a different level there if you'd want.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So you would want to keep the 500 cattle...

SENATOR SCHROCK: Uh-huh.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...as an automatic increase...

SENATOR SCHROCK: For those mid-sized producers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But if that were the number for these large ones also,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...it's telling me that...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any further lights on? Senator Wehrbein.
