SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature. Senator Schrock, could I ask you a little bit about this agreement you have with Senator Chambers?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, would you yield?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, I understood that with FA485 we were taking out 10 percent.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And what would remain would be the animal count limitations that were in the bill,...

SENATOR SCHROCK: Which was...yeah, which...and...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...which is...which in the case of cattle was 500.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Now tell me again what your understanding with Senator Chambers now is?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Okay. My understanding with Senator Chambers is that expansion will only apply to dairy cattle and beef cattle. And we have to draft that. We're not going to get that done this morning.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And that will...and dairy and...

SENATOR SCHROCK: Right.
