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SENATOR BAKER: No, the only...there is a provision in there that if they are not...or have been recognized and no longer recognized, then they can reapply. I'm trying to find that. It's in there, though, that says if they have not met the criteria and are removed from that approved list,...counsel is trying to direct me to page 6, line...such person...it's on line 18 on page 6. Director may summarily remove a person...you can read it for yourself. Such person may reapply for inclusion on the list upon presentation of...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, that's with respect to a person who's a representative that applies, right?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, that's right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: But with respect to the question of whether you're a recognized car club, there's no...

SENATOR BOURNE: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...formal appeal from that, although I assume you could reapply.

SENATOR BAKER: That's right. That's correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Then, when it gets down...of course, a qualified car club representative, as I understand it, is the one that's going to be signing these documents that verifies that the car qualifies for an historical license, right?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: All right, and they have to come from one of these recognized car clubs, right?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: All right. And down on page 5 it describes that this person has to be designated by the president or director of the local chapter. They have to be a member, and
