SENATOR BOURNE: Time. (Visitors introduced.) Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Baker, if I may continue the dialogue, we were on the qualified car club representative, the things they have to put into their application. And then it says the department shall place a qualified car club representative on the list, on the list of those qualified to inspect these vehicles, upon receipt of a complete application, and shall provide each representative with information for inspection of vehicles, and so forth. Is it...I assume that not only there has to be an application, but the right answers have to be given on the application, in order for them to qualify. Would that be accurate?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, it would.

SENATOR BEUTLER: All right. So really, the department has some discretion here. They don't have to place this qualified car club representative on the list just because they've received a complete application, right?

SENATOR BAKER: That's correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Would you have any objection to changing those two "shalls" on lines 26 and 27 to "mays"?

SENATOR BAKER: No, that would be fine with me.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. And then with respect to the criteria that's established for this qualified car club, I assume that the department in rule and reg could establish whatever criteria it deemed to be...whatever reasonable criteria it deemed necessary. Would that be accurate?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes. Yes, that would be within the club.
