The commission the appointments be confirmed by the Legislature. The committee first is Nancy Oltman, a reappointment for a four-year term; a medical transcription (sic) from Hastings; currently serves as second vice president for the National Federation for the Blind. Unable to appear in person, Senator Burling appeared in support of her confirmation. The second is Darrell Walla, a new appointment for a four-year term; a special education teacher from Burke High School in Omaha; board member of the National Federation for the Blind, Nebraska Chapter. Unable to appear in person, Senator Brashear's office offered testimony in support of his confirmation. Mr. President, I would just ask for confirmation of these two individuals.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jensen. You've heard the opening on the confirmation report by Health and Human Services Committee. Open for discussion. Senator Jensen, there are no lights on. You're recognized to close. Senator Jensen waives closing. Question before the body is, shall the first report offered by the Health and Human Services Committee be adopted? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Have you all voted on the first report who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
