SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, why would you read me something about a member who is not public? Is there a designation of anybody as being a public member?

SENATOR JENSEN: They're referred as public members.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Now that other category that you just mentioned, this lay member, what is that referring to?

SENATOR JENSEN: Not one of the designated individuals that are represented as a discipline.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And that is the same thing or the same role filled by the public member.
