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affiliation? Would you believe you're supposed to check that box?

SENATOR JENSEN: I probably would. I would probably check the box.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Most people would believe that, so why don't you tell the Governor to talk to DAS, or whoever put these forms together, and not put that box on the forms that relate to boards where political affiliation is not necessary?

SENATOR JENSEN: That's certainly a possibility.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, you're a Chairperson. Don't Chairpersons exercise leadership? Don't they? They're supposed to, aren't they?

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. And you have exercised leadership on various issues during the time that I've been here. That's a given.

SENATOR JENSEN: I hope so.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But I did not realize, until our discussion here, that political affiliation is required to be shown, and I'm going to say for this board it is required because the box is there. Let me ask you this question. Is there a line or a place to designate...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ... the name of the appointee?

SENATOR JENSEN: The name?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes, there is.
