SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain today is Pastor Kent Clark, Auburn Berean Church, Auburn, Nebraska; Senator Heidemann's district, District 1. Pastor, please.

PASTOR CLARK: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Pastor Clark, for being with us this morning. I call the thirty-sixth day, Ninety-Ninth Legislature, Second Session, to order. Senators, please record your presence. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Are there any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Reports, messages, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, a series of amendments to LB 834 by Senator Chambers. And a new resolution, LR 296, by Senator Cudaback; that will be laid over. That's all that I have at this time, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 829-830.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Next agenda item, Select File. Mr. Clerk, LB 478.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 478 is on Select File; has been discussed on Select File. Pending is an amendment by Senator Cornett, specifically AM1810, and Senator Chambers had offered FA448 as an amendment to Senator Cornett's amendment. Those two amendments are pending. (FA448, Legislative Journal page 672.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, as read by the Clerk, your amendment is pending to the Cornett amendment. You may...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, I'm ready. Thank you, Mr. President. Thank you, Mr. Clerk. On your gadget, you will see the
