get, are entitled to some kind of special consideration that the ordinary grunt veteran will not get. And maybe the grunt dresn't have a left hand, as I pointed out, but I'm not going to go into all that right now. But I'm very bitter. I discussed this in relatively bitter terms the other day and I'm going to continue it today, and you can cloture it if you want to. I don't even care about that now. But I want the public to know exactly what we're doing,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and that the Legislature knew what we were doing at the time. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Janssen, followed by Senator Cornett and others.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature. I've not entered in on the discussion of this. I've been sitting back, listening. I don't particularly care about granting relief or lower taxes or no taxes at all to a certain group of people, but the longer I listen to the discussion I think, all right, these are specialized people, people who have, in their military career, have done these particular types of jobs. Now we all know that there are a lot of chiefs on any project or any job. But the spin-off from that, I am concerned about other jobs that will be done not by these specialized people, the ones who have retired from the military and have the knowledge and experience of doing these types of jobs. You know, there, I'm sure...maybe Senator Cornett could respond to this a little later. If I have some time left, I'll give it to her. But would there not be other jobs, not quite as sophisticated as this particular job, that will evolve with that company being here and adding to the economy of the state and the community? Sitting, listening to this debate I thought, well, you know, maybe we're overlooking some other jobs that will be created with the high-tech jobs. Senator Cornett, I don't know how much time I have left, but I will yield the rest of my time to you and maybe you can answer some of these questions, if I'm on the right track.
