passed over. We now go on to general Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, the first vote will be to suspend the at-large reading of LB 875E. All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Vote is 43 ayes, 2 nays to dispense with the at-large reading, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The at-large reading is dispensed with. Mr. Clerk, please read the title to LB 875E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read title of LB 875.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 875E pass with the emergency clause attached? All in favor of the motion vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 902.) Vote is 48 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 875E passes with the emergency clause attached. That does complete Final Reading, members. Mr. Clerk, do you have any items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, the Appropriations Committee will have a meeting in Room 2022 now; Appropriations, Room 2022. That's all that I have at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We now go to General File, 2006 committee first priority bills. Mr. Clerk, LB 994.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 994 is a bill introduced by the Health and Human Services Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 9 of this year, referred to the Health Committee, advanced to General File. That's all that I have at this time, Mr. President.
