SENATOR BOURNE: The motion fails. We are back to the Jensen amendment. I raise the call. Senator Chambers, you're recognized to speak.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature, I would like to ask Senator Jensen some questions. Senator Jensen,...

SENATOR BOURNE: Excuse me. Senator Jensen, would you yield, please?

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes, I will.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Jensen, is everything in this amendment that we're discussing, AM2157, required by the federal government, or some things are added by the state, which are not necessarily required?

SENATOR JENSEN: No, we...the things that this amendment covers is required by the federal government.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would you turn to page 5 of your amendment?

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes, I will.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It would be the last page.

SENATOR JENSEN: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: In lines 12 and 13...

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...you strike the language, "A placement shall not exceed three months."

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes.
