SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Byars, are you...?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Byars, do you have it?

SENATOR BYARS: Counsel advises me it's because it's a difference in operational dates, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. But you do see where the identical language is in both lines. And with that explanation, everything has been taken care of. Thank you, Mr. President. Thank you, Senator Byars. Thank you, counsel.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You're welcome. (Laugh)

SENATOR CUDABACK: You're welcome. Further discussion? Seeing none, Senator Byars, you're recognized to close. Senator Byars waives closing. The question before the body is, shall the Byars amendment, AM2532, be adopted to LB 994? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. We're voting on the Byars amendment, AM2532. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 mays on adoption of AM2532, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment has been adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Byars would move to amend with AM2537.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Byars, to open on AM2537 to LB 994.

SENATOR BYARS: Mr. President, I would ask to withdraw that amendment and refile it on Select, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: So ordered. Mr. Clerk.
